After each application window, the panel process applications into a longlist who will be contacted for shortlisting and member voting before receiving the results

MASONIC CHARITABLE FOUNDATION

NEWBY TRUST - SMALL CHARITIES

Core Funding - or overheads, in particular for very small charities. May provide small grants for short-term emergency relief. Grants are usually in the range between £2,000 and £10,000 depending upon the size of your charity.

Most grants are single one-year payments but the Trust will consider grants of up to three years. In terms of continuing funding, the Trust is able to consider funding an organisation for up to five consecutive years before requiring a gap of at least three years.

The Trust accepts applications throughout the year. The Trustees consider applications at two meetings, usually in March and November. As a general rule, the Trust would recommend submitting completed applications at least two months in advance of each meeting.
